



When is a motor vehicle or mechanical equipment powered by an internal combustion engine non-hazardous?

A motor vehicle or mechanical equipment may be shipped as a non-hazardous material if one of the following conditions are met:

(1) When using a liquid fuel that has a flashpoint less than 38 °C (100°F), the fuel tank must be emptied, and the engine should be run until it stalls for lack of fuel;
or

(2) When using a liquid fuel that has a flashpoint of 38 °C (100 °F) or higher, the fuel tank contains 418 liters (110 gallons) of fuel or less, and there are no fuel leaks in any portion of the fuel system.

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
